1.	<p>The email for the <b>JAMA IV IDIQ Pilot Parts Program</b> program appears to be marked as CUI by you below your signature.</p> <p>The Government’s email is being sent to a server that is not allowed to contain CUI as our Company operates in the commercial Microsoft cloud, and I don't believe M365 Commercial is an allowable target for CUI emails. I also don't believe it meets all of the requirements set out by DFARS 252.204-7012.</p> <p>Can you please help us understand if your communications are overmarked in this case and if so, can you remove the markings?</p> <p>Is the DoD saying that it is ok to send CUI bodied emails to commercial email tenants now that are not in a Gov Cloud?</p>	<p>The RFP clearly states: “DLA will provide the selected additive manufacturing Technical Data Packages (TDPs) (DLA AM TDPs) of approved parts submitted by Military Services to be produced for this contract with Enhanced Joint Certification Program (eJCP) certified vendors via Internet Bid Board System (DIBBS) [and associated Collaboration cFolders]. The contract will include product definition, special instructions and acceptance criteria.”</p> <p>The JAMA IV program will not permit anything (e.g. sending CUI bodied emails to commercial email tenants) that is not in compliance with DoDI 5200.48 and its associated policies (EO 13556, 32CFR Part 2002, NIST SP 800-53, NIST SP 800-171, and NIST SP 800-172).</p>
